

Software Upgrade - U4

This guide will take you through upgrading the software on your Beyonwiz U4 via USB.

Note: Upgrading the firmware via USB will not delete any of your recordings, it will however delete any timers or settings you have made, if you want to keep these settings you can back them up prior to doing the upgrade by going to Setup>>Software Manager>>Create Backup. On first boot after the upgrade you will be asked if you want to restore from backup.

- Step 1.** Download the latest version of the Firmware from our downloads page by clicking on the following link: <https://beyonwiz.com.au/downloads/>
 - Step 2.** Once you download the file Unzip or Extract it and find the folder names beyonwiz.
 - Step 3.** Insert a USB stick into a USB slot on your computer, if there are previous Beyonwiz upgrade files on the stick you “Must” delete them. If it is a new USB stick that you have not used for an upgrade before you should format it in FAT32 format. Now Copy and Paste the beyonwiz folder to a USB stick, it should not be inside a folder, it must be in the root or top level of the USB stick.
* Tip: Older, small USB sticks seem to work the best.
 - Step 4.** Make sure that your Beyonwiz is in Shutdown mode or the rear switch is turned off, also make sure that no other USB devices are connected to the PVR.
 - Step 5.** Connect the USB stick to either the front or rear USB ports and power the PVR ‘ON’ and watch the front display.
 - Step 6.** The Front Display will advise that an update is available and the front power button will start to blink, simply touch the blinking power button to start the upgrade. The process will be displayed on the PVR display, it will display scrolling text such as “Flash Kernel” and “Flash Rootfs”, DONOT turn the PVR off during the process, it will take anywhere from 5 - 10mins depending on the speed of your USB stick.
 - Step 7.** Once the Upgrade is complete the PVR will reboot, it will then find the upgrade again and ask you to start upgrade as previously, just ignor this and it will boot up after 10seconds, you can remove your USB stick now.
 - Step 8.** Your PVR will now boot up into the Setup Wizard, if you backed up your settings you will be asked if you want to restore from back up first, if not it will go through the setup wizard again.
